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Pune College gets India's First of its kind 'Ink Lab'

PVG College of Engineering and Technology, Pune in collaboration with Siegwerk India, set up a unique lab to help spur the Ink Technology ecosystem



30th March 2017, Pune: Siegwerk India in association with Parakh Agro announced the setting up of India's comprehensive, first of its kind INK LAB in Printing Engineering Department at PVG's College of Engineering and Technology, Pune (PVG's COET). PVG's COET is the driving force behind graduating 60 print specialists every year. So far, the college has produced more than 1600 print specialists over the last 27 years.

This initiative will set to be a two-pronged enabler that will look at training students on live projects, understand substrate-ink interaction for problem solving and reach out to the current existing workforce from the industry to enhance and improve their existing skills by inviting them to use the Ink Lab.
