With *SICURA Flex Dual Cure*, Siegwerk will also showcase a dual-cure system suitable for non-food applications as well as food packaging where processing conditions preclude the possibility of set-off and the final printed packaging ensures reliable functional barrier properties against migration.

“With our latest developments of dual-cure inks for food and non-food applications, we are making it even easier for our customers not only to switch to more eco-friendly production processes without compromising on performance, but also to already meet the requirements of the upcoming regulations like GIO,” explains Marc Larvor, Head of Technology Narrow Web EMEA at Siegwerk.
