



Declaration of Conformity to the EuPIA Exclusion Policy

In 1996, the then European sector group of the printing ink industry took over existing national stewardship initiatives to create the first Exclusion List for Printing Inks and Related Products. Over the years, the list evolved into a comprehensive policy, the latest version of which can be found at www.eupia.org.
Siegwerk has been committed to following the Exclusion List since its introduction, and continues to uphold its commitment to the EuPIA Exclusion Policy.
For better transparency, the list of companies following the EuPIA Exclusion Policy was made publicly available in 2021, at <https://www.eupia.org/our-commitment/eupia-exclusion-policy-for-printing-inks-and-rel>.

In general, all products supplied by Siegwerk are formulated in accordance with the principles of the EuPIA Exclusion Policy.
Therefore, the use of substances and mixtures classified in the following hazard classes/categories, shown with their respective hazard statement codes, is excluded:

GROUP A

- Acute Toxicity Cat. 1 & 2 [H300, H310, H330]
- Acute Toxicity Cat. 3 (inhalation) [H331]
- Carcinogen or Mutagen Cat. 1A & 1B [H350, H340]
- Toxic to Reproduction Cat. 1A & 1B [H360] (*non-threshold substances*)
- STOT Single Exposure Cat. 1 [H370]

GROUP B

- Acute Toxicity Cat. 3 (oral, dermal) [H301, H311]
- Toxic to Reproduction Cat. 1A & 1B [H360] (*if threshold exists*)
- STOT Repeated Exposure Cat. 1 [H372]

The use of pigment colorants, specifically compounds based on antimony, arsenic, cadmium, chromium (VI), lead, mercury and selenium, as well as of certain dyes, solvents, plasticizers and miscellaneous materials as outlined in Annex 1 of the EuPIA Exclusion Policy is also excluded.
